

Absentee Voting

If you are unable to vote in-person on Election Day, you have the option to vote via an absentee ballot. To be eligible to vote absentee one of the following criteria must be met:

- Absent from St. Louis County on Election Day.
- Incapacity or confinement due to sickness or disability or caregiver of a confined or disabled person.
- Religious belief or practice.
- Employment by the Election Board.
- Imprisonment (provided all other qualifications for voting are retained.)

All mail absentee requests must be received in our office by 5:00 PM the Wednesday prior to the election.

Voting an absentee ballot in our office is available until 5:00 PM the day before the election.

Mailed absentee ballots must be received in our office by 7:00 PM on Election Day to be counted.

Permanently Disabled

If you are permanently disabled, or a caregiver for one who is, you can apply to have your name included on our permanently disabled list.

Once on the list, you will automatically receive an application to vote by absentee for every election that you are eligible.
